## TRAIN THE TRAINERS

The next session for Train the Trainers in Backward Design will be held at the Pastoral Center from 4:00-6:00pm on **November 14<sup>th</sup>**. This year the focus will continue to be integrating the new archdiocesan math standards and best practices into the Backward Design model. Additional dates are January 9<sup>th</sup>, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, March 6<sup>th</sup>, and April 10<sup>th</sup>.

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL MATH STUDY

The math in-depth study will be due **April 2018**. This year we will collaborate to unpack the standards, create curriculum maps and backward design units, and then next year we will write the math in-depth study. Those teachers and principals who attended the math and backward design professional development on October 14<sup>th</sup>, had a great introduction from Dr. Nicole Ralston to the shifts in mathematics and an introduction to the 8 mathematical practices included in the new math standards.
