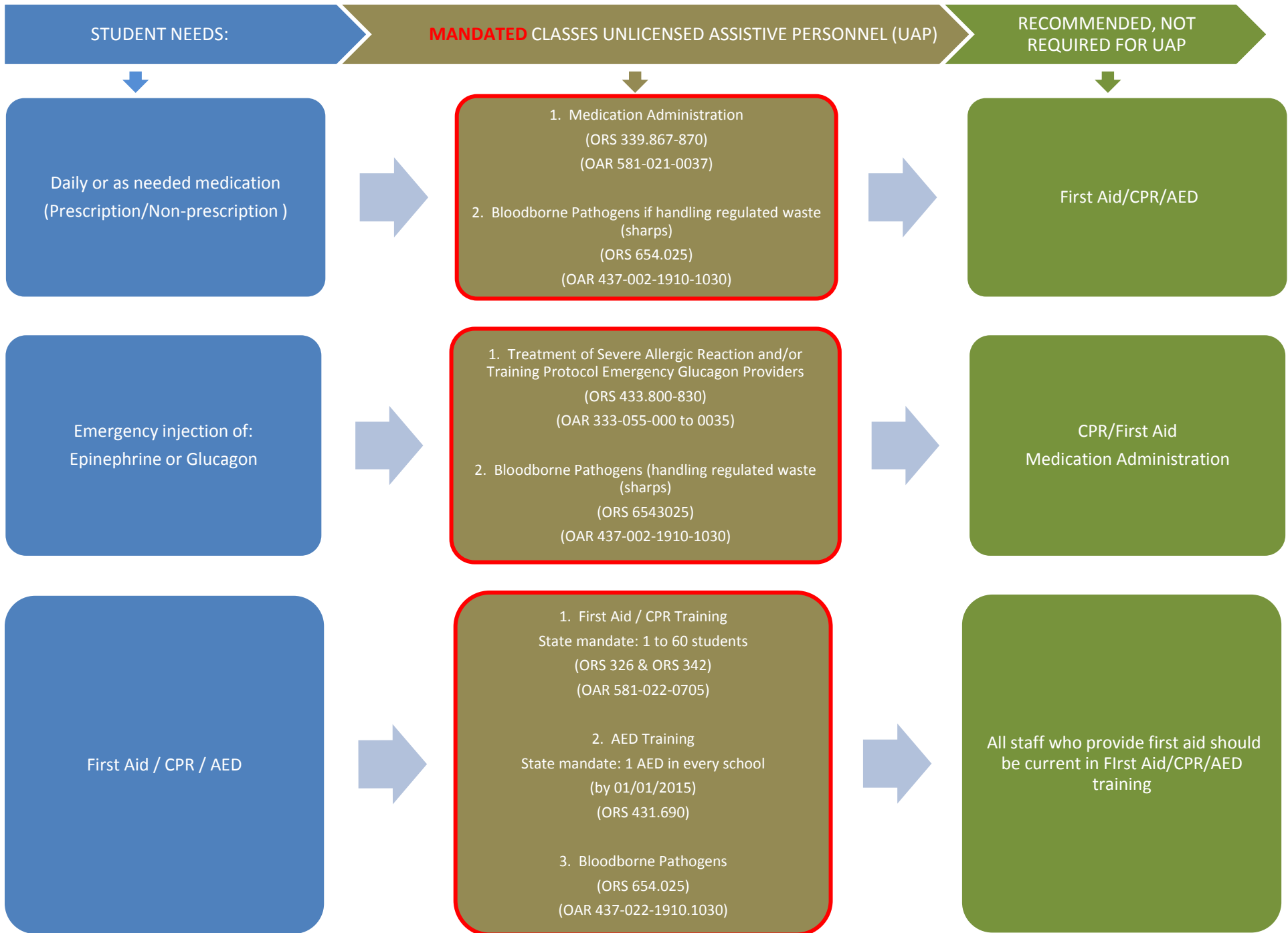


TRAINING REQUIRED FOR UNLICENSED ASSISTIVE PERSONNEL (UAP)



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By definition of the Oregon State Board of Nursing, **UAP** “is a person who may have training which documents their knowledge and competency but they do not have a scope of practice or authorized nursing tasks.” Each class has definite requirements for the instructor and a defined length of time for the subject matter training to be in effect for.

HEALTH TRAINING CLASS	INSTRUCTOR	LENGTH OF CERTIFICATION	INITIAL CLASS	RENEWAL
Blood Borne Pathogens	OHSA requires instructor be familiar with work environment, available at time of class for questions, able to demonstrate appropriate personal protective equipment.	1 year (365 days)	75 min.	On line
Medication Administration	RN, pharmacist or physician licensed in state of Oregon and familiar with delivery of health services in school setting.	1 year (365 days)	120 min.	On line
Severe Allergic Reaction/Anaphylaxis	Physician, nurse practitioner, licensed to practice in Oregon or an RN delegated by above physician or nurse practitioner.	3 Years	90 min.	Only in person
Glucagon	Same as severe allergic reaction	3 Years	90 min.	Only in person
First Aid/CPR/AED	Trained to 2010 American Heart Association standard. Participants must be able to complete return demonstrations.	2 Years	240 min. (4 hours)	Only in person
