

Learning Specialist Position- Immediate Opening

St. Agatha Catholic School is seeking highly qualified applicants to fill a Learning Support Specialist position. It is part-time at approximately .6 FTE. A successful candidate must have a current Oregon teaching license. Catholic preferred. An endorsement(s) in reading, math, Special Education or equivalent experience is required. Special Education endorsement strongly preferred. This position is benefits eligible.

Our Learning Support Center is a unique and dynamic program. Our team includes two part time specialists, a counselor, and an instructional aide providing small group or one on one support for students. We are looking for team member who brings experience working with students with special needs. Students receiving services are on accommodation or Individualized Learning Plans, and push in or pull out instruction is tailored to the individual needs of the child. Under the direction of the principal, the Learning Specialist plans and provides appropriate learning experiences for students with disabilities in a variety of educational settings.

The role of the Learning Specialist is to support students with different learning styles by providing intervention; support teachers in their efforts to advance students with different learning needs within the classroom; work with parents, students, and outside professionals in order to better support special needs students. The teacher's broad area of responsibility is to ensure that each student may learn and flourish spiritually, intellectually, socially, and physically. Each student, guided by the Learning Specialist is expected to achieve at a high academic and personal level, according to his/her potential.
